Approval – Dangerous Goods Training Course

1 Revocation

Instrument CASA.DGTNG.0052 Revision: 0 is hereby revoked.

2 Application

This instrument applies to DG & Safety Pty Ltd [ARN: 809394] (the **company**), the training course materials submitted to CASA, for persons with Group B, C, D, or F responsibilities (the **training courses**) and persons who undertake a training course (the **persons**).

3 Approval

The *training courses* are approved as being appropriate for:

- a) Group B employees;
- b) Group C employees;
- c) Group D employees;
- d) Group F employees; and
- e) Employees with a combination of responsibilities for Groups B, C, D or F; as per the matrices contained within Schedule 1.

4 Conditions

- a) Only changes to the Civil Aviation Act 1988, the Civil Aviation Safety Regulations 1998, the International Civil Aviation Organization - Technical Instructions for the Safe Transport of Dangerous Goods by Air, and the International Air Transport Association - Dangerous Goods Regulations, in force from time to time, may be reflected in the training course without CASA approval.
- b) A person may only undertake the recertification training course if, within the two year period, as defined in CASR 92.090, immediately preceding their attendance at this course, they have undertaken an initial training course approved for Groups B, C and D employees covering all classes of dangerous goods.
- c) A person may only undertake the recertification training course if, within the two year period, as defined in CASR 92.090, immediately preceding their attendance at this course, they have undertaken an initial training course approved for Group F employees covering all classes of dangerous goods limited to the recertification course.
- d) The company is required to keep records of courses, students and instructors for a minimum period of 36 months from the completion of the course.
- e) The company is to make training records available to the Civil Aviation Safety Authority for audit and compliance purposes upon request.
- f) This approval is subject to a satisfactory standard of course being maintained.
- g) The Civil Aviation Safety Authority may revoke this approval if it is necessary in the interests of the safety of air navigation.

5 Expiry

This Instrument expires at the end of November 2019.
