- 1. Name**
This instrument is *CASA.DGTNG.0052 Revision 3 - Dangerous Goods Training Course Approval, 2022* (this instrument may be abbreviated as *CASA.DGTNG.0052.3*).
- 2. Application**

Schedule 2

Conditions

1. A person may only undertake a recertification training course or be eligible to undertake a test of competency if, within the two-year (or 24-monthly) period, as defined in regulation 92.090 of CASR, immediately preceding their attendance at this course or test of competence, they have undertaken an initial training course approved for at least the equivalent Group employees covering all relevant classes or divisions of dangerous goods.
2. The training provider must (a) keep training and assessment records for a minimum period of 36 months from the most recent training and assessment completion month and (b) make these records available to trainee(s) (but only the relevant trainee's records) or the Civil Aviation Safety Authority upon request.
3. Within 7 days of a training provider ceasing to trade, it must provide to CASA an electronic copy of its training for the period of 36 months prior to it ceasing to trade.
